# NUMBER OF PERSONS RECEIVING A SALARY


👤 In November 2025, the number of persons receiving a monthly salary stood at **996,988\***, which was 0.8% lower than in October 2025 and 1.0% less than in November 2024.

👤 In November 2025, the share of persons receiving a monthly salary up to **600 GEL** amounted to **12.4%**, which was 0.2 percentage points higher than in October 2025 and 4.0 percentage points less than in November 2024.


👤 In November 2025, the share of persons receiving a monthly salary of **2,400 GEL or more** amounted to **33.2%**, which was 1.1 percentage points lower than in October 2025 and 4.5 percentage points more than in November 2024.

👤 In November 2025, the share of persons receiving a monthly salary of **9,600 GEL or more** amounted to **2.9%**, which was 0.3 percentage points lower than in October 2025 and 0.5 percentage points more than in November 2024.

# TOTAL VACANCIES PUBLISHED ON **jobs.ge**


👤 In November 2025, the total number of vacancies published on jobs.ge amounted to 6,528, which was 14.9% lower compared to October 2025 and 5.0% higher compared to November 2024. This year-over-year increase was driven by a low base effect, as vacancies declined sharply in November 2024.

👤 The smallest month-over-month decrease was observed in logistics and distribution (-10.1%), while the biggest decrease among main categories was in administration and management (-14.9%).

👤 The largest year-over-year increase was observed in IT and programming (+59.5%), while the decrease was only in administration and management category (-0.9%).

👤 From September 2025 to November 2025, the total number of vacancies published on jobs.ge amounted to 22,932, which was 2.4% higher compared to the same period of 2024. The category that contributed the most to the increase during this period was finance and statistics.

# VACANCIES PUBLISHED ON **jobs.ge** BY CATEGORY

From September 2025 to November 2025, a total of 998 vacancies were published in the field of IT and Programming, which was 54.5% higher compared to the corresponding period of 2024.

From September 2025 to November 2025, a total of 4,759 vacancies were published in the field of finance and statistics, which was 16.0% higher compared to the corresponding period of 2024.

From September 2025 to November 2025, a total of 6,162 vacancies were published in the field of sales and procurement, which was 8.9% higher compared to the corresponding period of 2024.

Graph 4: Number of Vacancies Published on **jobs.ge** by Category














Graph 5: Quarterly Average Number of Persons Receiving a Salary (by Salary Range)
